LASER FOR WRINKLES AND LAXITY: PRIME, MAINTAIN, AND ENHANCE TREATMENT FOR WRINKLES AND LAXITY

Created to address the needs of aging skin, this firming and rejuvenating treatment primes skin for laser procedures by initiating the rejuvenation process and supporting collagen synthesis. When performed in a series, it helps reduce the appearance of fine lines, wrinkles, and skin laxity.

FOR BEST RESULTS: Perform the first treatment 2 weeks prior to the laser procedure. Maintain and Enhance results after laser procedures with one treatment per month for a series of 6 treatments.

1. PRE-CLEANSE (optional)	Remove eye and lip makeup with Gentle Cleanser on a pre-moistened cotton round.	
2. CLEANSE	Cleanse the face with Simply LHA Cleanser on 4x4 rough gauze pads. Rinse with 4x4 rough gauze pads moistened with water.	
3. TONE	Tone and further exfoliate the patient's skin by using LHA Solution on dry 4x4 rough gauze pads or soft gauze pads for very sensitive skin.	
4. EXFOLIATE	Mix 5-7 drops of Retexturing Activator [®] with Clarifying Clay Masque . Gently massage the mixture on the face for 5 minutes. Dampen as necessary with water to prevent the mixture from caking.	
5. SHIELD	Apply Hydra Balm with a cotton applicator to the outer canthus of the patient's eyes, in nasal-labial folds, around the nostrils, on the lips beginning at the vermillion border and any visible irritated areas.	
6. CHEMICAL PEEL	Pour 5cc of either Micropeel 20 or Micropeel 30 Solution into a plastic medicine cup. The peel solution is applied to the face with soft gauze. Set the timer for 2 minutes and start the timer <u>upon beginning initial application</u> of the acid. Quickly apply one even layer of the Micropeel Solution to the entire face avoiding the eyes and mouth. Leave the acid on the face no longer than 2 minutes from the first stroke. Normal signs of activity include pinkness, mild itching and tingling. Depending on skin condition, erythema and tolerance, the acid may need to be neutralized and removed prior to two minutes. To decrease the discomfort during the chemical peel application, a fan can be used.	

7. NEUTRALIZE	At the first sign of pinkness or after 5 minutes, neutralize the entire treated area with 4x4 soft gauze saturated in Peel Neutralizer . Continue neutralization until tingling subsides. Once neutralization is complete, rinse the area thoroughly with copious amounts of cold water with saturated 4x4 soft gauze pads.	
8. EXTRACTIONS (optional)	Pore extractions may be performed on mature pustules as needed.	
9. CALM	Apply the Biocellulose Restorative Masque to further replenish the skin, leaving on the patient for 10 minutes. No rinsing is necessary after removing the masque.	
10. FIRM (optional for priming)	In small bowl mix two pumps of Gentle Cleanser , 3-5 drops of Phyto Corrective Gel , and one scoop of Vitamin C Firming Masque . Apply to the entire face with soft gauze. If using alone allow the masque to dry for 5-7 minutes; if proceeding to next optional step, allow the masque to dry for 3 minutes. Remove the masque and rinse thoroughly with 4x4 soft gauze saturated with cool water.	
11. PREVENT	Apply 3-5 drops of C E Ferulic [®] to the entire face.	
12. CORRECT	Apply Retexturing Activator [®] to accelerate cell differentiation. Apply a thin veil of A.G.E. Interrupter to the entire treated area.	
13. PROTECT	Apply an adequate amount of Sheer Physical UV Defense SPF 50, Physical Fusion UV Defense SPF 50 or Physical UV Defense SPF 30 to entire face.
